This is a pre-registration clinic: if you need to cancel from the clinic, you must contact the clinic coordinator at least 48 hours prior to the start of the clinic. If you do not get this confirmation, double the hours that you signed up for will be deducted from your educational hours.

Clinic Objective: The purpose of this clinic is to help participants practice skills to improve transitions, cadence and balance for western pleasure as well as group rail work and individual patterns will be utilized in this clinic.

A total of four sections are offered with a limit of 10 riders per section.

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| 8:00 – 9:30 AM | Beginner Walk Trot Equitation & Pleasure – Limited or some experience with walk and trot transitions and proper leads but, are still developing skills, or intermediate/advanced riders that have novice/green horses. Review show ring etiquette. |
| 10:00 – 11:30 AM | Intermediate Walk Trot Equitation - Limited to some experience with walk, canter transitions and proper leads but, are still developing skills and learning pattern work. Review show ring etiquette. |
| 12:00 – 1:30 PM | Intermediate Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and Pleasure -Intermediate skill level to include riding the rail and pattern at the walk, trot, canter using leg yields, riding circles and doing 360-degree pivots. Review show ring etiquette. |
| 2:00 – 3:30 PM | Advanced – Advanced Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and Pleasure - Advanced skill level of the rider, using the correct form and aids (hands, legs, seat, weight and voice) to produce the maximum performance of the horse. Review proper show ring etiquette. |
